- Promptly report in writing to the customer any observed variances from the design and construction contract requirements.

- Review contract drawings, Specifications, and approved submittals in preparation for upcoming inspections.
- Request changes to the contract and track contract modification.
- Coordinate internal resources and third parties/vendors for the flawless execution of projects
- Ensure that all projects are delivered on-time, within scope and within budget
- Manage changes to the project scope, project schedule, and project costs using appropriate verification techniques
- Successfully manage the relationship with the client and all stakeholders
- Perform risk management to minimize project risks
